### Architect/Design

In an effort to help revitalize downtown Juneau, Jill Ramiel and Ken Alper opened Silverbow Inn in June 1997 after a three-month remodel. A decade later, Ramiel hired an architect, with whom she worked closely, to plan and design the Inn's 11-room renovation.

### General Description

Housed in the historic 1914 Messerschmidt Building in the heart of historic downtown Juneau, Silverbow Inn delightfully blurs the line between bed and breakfast and boutique hotel. The property is defined by an eclectic collection of antiques and memorabilia, tastefully hip décor, and warm, attentive service. Owners are the husband and wife team of New York émigrés, Jill Ramiel and Ken Alper. Silverbow Inn is heralded as Juneau's most sophisticated hotel for both business and leisure travelers. Featuring 11 modern rooms, its central downtown location is just 14 miles from the Ferry Terminal and 9 miles from Juneau Airport. Silverbow Inn is within walking distance of the waterfront, convention center, State Capitol Building and South Franklin Street shops and restaurants. The restored property was designed to create a stylish, yet relaxing environment, supplemented by a full range of services and unique features, including a cinema, art gallery and Alaska's oldest operating bakery. It serves as

the civic and social hub of downtown Juneau, where politicians, artists, young couples, new mamas, and local laborers convene to exchange conversation and ideas. Silverbow Inn is the result of Owner/Architect Ramiel's individual style and vision, where edgy meets elegant. It serves much more than a "home away from home," but a reinvention of the authentic Juneau experience.

**Lobby**

Silverbow Inn's lobby welcomes guests with warm, antique and memorabilia-filled environs. It's a convivial place where guests mingle over board games and puzzles and pore over local guidebooks, complimentary coffee and tea, and a general use computer. There are several photo albums chronicling the history of the Inn, as well as a guestbook filled with guest's fond memories. After hour arrivals are greeted with an expedited check-in process, fresh fruit, popcorn and hot noodles and cocoa.

**Bakery/Restaurant**

Alaska's oldest operating bakery, Silverbow Bakery & Café is a popular stop with both locals and travelers for pre-work coffee and pastries, soups, sandwiches and salads at lunch and dinner, or a nightcap of wine, beer or dessert.

**Back Room Cinema/Gallery**

Back Room Cinema is Juneau's premier art house movie theater showing new, classic and independent films on an 11-foot screen. Noted for its distinctive beer and wine selections, made-from-scratch desserts and vibrant social atmosphere, an evening at Back Room Cinema is a unique experience.

**Catering**

Silverbow Catering offers creative options for groups needing meeting space and/or catering services. Buy out the Back Room for private functions up to 80 guests, or let Silverbow Catering host your corporate or private event offsite – anywhere from the Convention Center to atop a glacier – and create the ultimate entertaining experience.

**Guest Accommodations**

Eleven rooms are furnished with clean, modern interiors and stylish accessories. Creamy white walls complement dark wood furnishings and rich, earth-hued accents. Common features include private baths, complimentary full breakfast, complimentary high speed wireless internet service, free local calls, direct phone number and voicemail, premium cable television, daily housekeeping service. Beds are kitted with 400-thread count sheets and luxurious linens. Black-out drapes and fresh Northwest air

ensure a restful night's sleep. Bathrooms feature plush, fluffy towels, brushed steel and glass fixtures, hair dryers, bubble bath/bath salts, and large shower/bath combinations. The Mount Jumbo Room features a jetted, Jacuzzi tub. Modern room amenities include CD players, iPod docking stations, cordless phones, clock radios, flat screen televisions, and come equipped irons and ironing boards, umbrellas, extra space heaters and blankets. Guests of Silverbow Inn also have access to the Jacuzzi and sauna on the roof deck (bathrobes available at front desk). More than a dozen additional complimentary items are available upon request. Silverbow Inn is a non-smoking property.

#### **Guest Services**

Guests of Silverbow Inn have access to limited off-street parking, same day laundry service (fee), ice, guest mini refrigerator, 24-hour coffee and tea service, daypacks and rain gear. For business travelers, meeting rooms, facsimile services (fee) and a 24-hour computer station is available. For late-check outs, luggage and gear storage is available. During the summer season, guests may enjoy a bottomless cookie jar, hosted nightly wine and cheese tastings and tour booking services.

#### **Room Type Descriptions**

The **Mount Jumbo Room** features a King bed, private whirlpool bath, and 100-year old maple floors. Seven **Hill View Rooms** feature a Queen or Kings bed and a private full bath. **Large Family Room** (sleeps up to 4) features a Queen bed, two twin beds and a private full bath. Three **Economy Rooms** feature a Queen bed and a private 3/4 or full bath. All King beds can be made into two Twin beds upon request. All rooms feature complimentary high speed wireless internet service, free local calls, direct phone number and voicemail, and premium cable television.

#### **Reservations and Rates**

Weekly and monthly rates are available (low season only). High season runs from May to September and 2010 rates range from \$149 to \$209 per night, full breakfast included.
